Busy with limited parking. Arrive an hour before lunch opens. Use the time to hike around the pond trail.

#### PARK LOOP ROAD SAND BEACH/THUNDER HOLE



Arrive just after sunrise

Head immediately to Park Loop Rd (Sand Beach > Thunder Hole) after sunrise.




